

IMPACT OF PUPIL PREMIUM SPENDING ON ATTAINMENT, 2015-16

The achievement of Pupil Premium (PP) and non-Pupil Premium pupils has been substantially improved for those taking GCSEs at Witton Park. The tables below compare the achievement of pupils at Witton Park and pupils nationally. Until 2015 the Pupil Premium pupils at Witton Park were well above the national average for Pupil Premium in the 5A*-C inc. English and Maths measure. The national issue with the English iGCSE qualification has impacted negatively on performance of Pupil Premium pupils. Compared to national attainment data from 2014 Pupil Premium pupils were still attaining equivalent to national. We expect the comparison in 2016 to compare favourably.

In relation to pupils in English making 3 levels progress there is a similar pattern of closing the gap until 2014 then a widening in 2015. The achievement gap between all pupils and Pupil Premium pupils had significantly closed and there was little gap between them. Both of these progress levels were substantially above the national average. In 2015 the progress of pupils has decreased although there remains little gap between Pupil Premium students and all pupils. The 2016 progress figures demonstrate that 2015 was just a 'blip'. Progress figures, for all pupils and Pupil Premium pupils, in English will be above national when the national data is released.

In relation to pupils in Maths making 3 levels progress the achievement gap between all pupils and Pupil Premium pupils has significantly closed and there remains little gap between them. Both of these levels are substantially above the national average – and have been for a number of years.
